A Report from Africa



We are excited to share a report from the response Nick's team received when teaching the new curriculum based on Josh's book, *12 Crucial Truths of the Christian Faith,* in Southern Africa. The purpose of the trip was to equip lay preachers with an introduction to theology and church history as part of a certification program for them.

He was also able to teach 60 full-time oncampus students from southern Africa and 350 online students. The trip revealed just how great the need is for training and curriculum like the ones they are producing. Training resources in Southern Africa (across South Africa, Mozambique, Namibia, Swaziland, etc.) are extremely limited while the need for training church leaders, local staff, seminary students, and volunteers is high.

12 Crucial Truths of the Christian Faith is an excellent curriculum for this area of the world because it deals with the basics of the Christian faith including truth, theology, evidence for the Bible, apologetics, and application for living out the truth in day-to-day life.

Networking in the Southern African region will be needed to move forward to meet the need and have a significant



impact there with the JMM training resources and curriculums. Many parts of this area are fractured by war and terrorism. Building trusting relationships as well as providing the resources will be an important part of the process.

His Bible plans found in the *YouVersion* Bible App have one of the highest completion rates on the app. 1.6 million people report that they have taken *"the next step"* in their relationship with God because of Ben's content.
